



## NEW ZEALAND RALLY HERITAGE AWARDS

### **PURPOSE**

**‘To recognise those people who have consistently made an outstanding contribution to rallying in New Zealand’.**

### **OUTLINE**

The NZ Rally Heritage Awards are modelled on the Australian Rally Hall of Fame that was first established in 2013. Those awarded will be recognised for their extended contribution (minimum 8-10 years) to the sport in New Zealand.

Recognition will take the form of presentation of a citation and inclusion on the MSNZ website and other media.

The awards will fit as a secondary tier under the MotorSport NZ Wall of Fame which remains the sport’s premier recognition for those who have succeeded at an international level.

### **CRITERIA**

Membership will be on an individual basis – not a group, organisation or company. People awarded a Rally Heritage Award shall have made an outstanding contribution over many years to the sport (minimum 8-10 years). Awards may be made posthumously.

#### ***This may include recognition of:***

- a)** Sporting Performance as a NZ licence holder *and/or*
- b)** Event organisation or promotion *and/or*
- c)** Contribution as an official *and/or*
- d)** Exceptional other service (e.g. Journalist, Photographer or Sponsor)

Membership is not restricted to New Zealanders but the award shall recognise their contribution to the sport in NZ.

All nominations must be accompanied by a citation to be prepared by a nominated person and should be of sufficient length to adequately describe their contribution (i.e. 300-400 words).
