

CONTACT TRACING

How to utilise the government's contact tracing app

Under COVID-19 Alert Level 2 contact tracing at all motorsport events is required. Clubs should utilise the government's contact tracing app to carry out this requirement. Everyone entering a venue holding a motorsport event must complete some form of contact tracing.

First, organising clubs must create their QR code tracking code poster using the online form at <https://qrform.tracing.covid19.govt.nz>. Clubs should do this at least three days prior to the event commencing where possible.

We recommend each club registers the QR tracking code to the name and physical address of the club rather than the event name and venue, then use the same poster for each event the club hosts going forward.

Once the form is completed, you will be emailed a copy of your club's QR code tracking poster which you should print out and display at your event.

As people enter the venue they can then complete their contact tracing quickly and easily using the NZCOVID Tracer app on their smartphone. You can download the app at <https://tracing.covid19.govt.nz> for both Android and iOS (Apple) devices. We recommend downloading and signing up to the app before attending any events.
